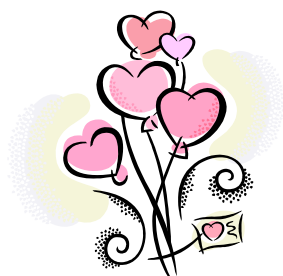

You should bring your sewing machine, rotary cutter and mat, basic sewing supplies, and any small scraps you have been collecting. If you don’t bring materials, you can still participate in the program by planning your projects to take home and sew. We plan to stay until 3:00pm, so please bring a sack lunch. If any of you have made a small scrap project, please bring it for show and tell.

Joany Orsi is presenting a trunk show of her beautiful quilts at our February 27 night meeting. Please come to see what a talented quilter we have as a fellow member!

At both the March and April day meetings, the theme will be modern quilting presented by Doreen Thornton and Linda Herren. The March 13 program is all about “What is a Modern Quilt?” If you have made a modern quilt we would like to invite you to bring it to this meeting to show to our members.

The first Saturday workshop of the year will be March 15 at Pickleweeds Quilt Shop, 9:00am-1:00pm. Tammy Silvers will be teaching her kaleidoscope quilt, “Fractures” (which she’s created just for us!). The show people are asking that this be sent in by the end of January and quilts would be sent to Savannah in March.

No report from the Historian or the Hospitality persons at this time.

Librarian announced that the books were there to be checked out.

Programs: Linda Jones announced that we were having Sarah Sorenson demonstrating the Strip Ruler at this morning's meeting. Albertha Brown will present a Trunk Show at the January night meeting. Our next workshop will be held on March 15 (Saturday) with Tammy Silvers. She will be teaching a special quilt made especially for our Guild. This will be on the Website soon. The workshop will be limited to 20 people and will cost \$20.

Finishing up Club: No more UFO's in 2014. We need to provide a list of UFO's to Emma Parker as she is heading this up. There will be two groups: Long arm and Non-long Arm. These UFO's must have been started before 2014 and finished and shown at Show and Tell before or by the November night meeting. Great prizes will be given at the December Christmas Party. Door prizes were won by Dawn Feist, Vickie Pruitt, Patti Howell and Rebekah Bobell.

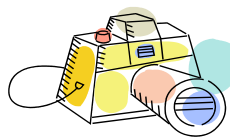

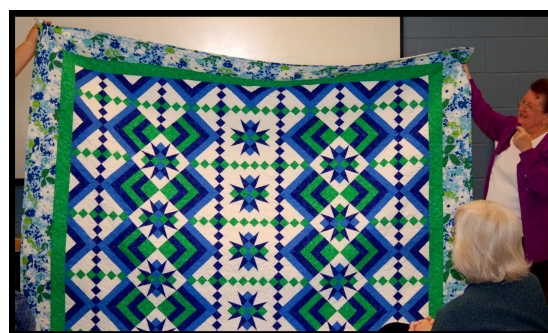

## **Minutes: CROG Night Meeting, January 23, 2014**

The meeting was called to order by the President, Tina Corbitt. She asked if there were any corrections to the newsletter and it was noted that the correct date for the Saturday Stitch-In is February 1, not Feb 2.

Tina recognized January birthdays of Charlie Phaneuf and Loretta Ford.

Treasurer Report - Our account is \$8,000 plus. Still due is a balance for rent in 2013. An invoice received for the entire year of 2014 from Hunter Park. Tina will speak with them. Our rent has increased from \$40 to \$50 per meeting in our regular meeting room. Ballroom increased from \$80 per event to \$150 for the February Stitch-In and \$250 per event thereafter. Stitch-Ins are self-supporting and increases do not affect the budget.

Bee Keeper – The February Bee will be at Irene Gardner's home. Lunch will be provided.

Challenge Quilt - Libby Armstrong will introduce information for this year's challenge quilt in February.

Christmas Party - Caryl Knox said that details will be forthcoming starting in February.

Community Service is still in need of one more people. No program has been decided on.

Hospitality - Vickie Pruitt is planning 3 dates for hospitality - April, July and October.

Membership - Denise Allee said that we have 51 paid members as of January 23. We had one visitor, Anita Zachary, and one new member, Octavia Hedge. Door prize winners were Caryl Knox and Albertha Brown. Denise also announced that the Fat Quarter Lottery has been discontinued by a vote taken at the Christmas party.

Newsletter - Vickie Pruitt said have articles in no later than the Sat. night following the Night Meeting.

Programs - Linda Jones announced a "contest" for this year to encourage everyone to finish their UFO's! Check website under "Announcements" for rules. Linda also reviewed upcoming programs. Please check website for full details.

It was also suggested that as we go through the year, we each keep our own "box of goodies" for the R'auktion, and sometime before the big day it can come together & be sorted.

There was no report for the following committees: Georgia Quilt Council, Historian, Librarian, Photographer, Publicity, Telephone and Webmaster.

New Business - Tina presented the proposed budget; measure was unanimously to accept it. Libby Armstrong shared information about a King size quilt frame for sale for \$50.

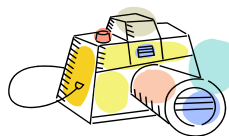

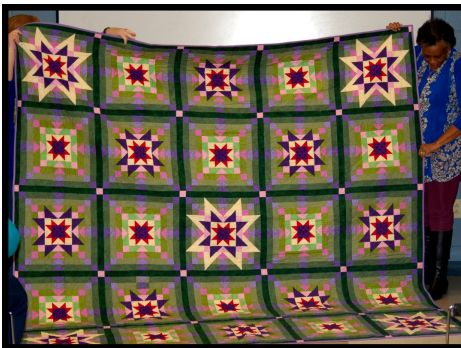

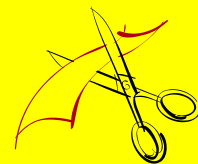
**Rules:**
