Have fun trying out new designs and colors, and keep in mind just how delighted a child will be in December!



CRQG Program News

At the day program on August 14, Doreen Thornton will teach how to make an Improvisational Bird Block. You need to bring 2 fat quarters of a medium saturated solid/or tone-on-tone fabric, your sewing machine, rotary cutter and mat...that's all! All other fabric will be provided. Bring your lunch since we plan to play for several hours.

Our August 28 night program will be presented by Stacy Michell. Her program is called "Aloha Ya'll". She will share with us her story, a few tips and discuss the workshop she will be teaching on September 6.

Our second Saturday workshop of the year will be September 6 at Pickleweeds Quilt Shop. We have Stacy Michell teaching her "2 for 1 Hula" class. The guild is keeping the cost of the class down to a charge of only \$10. However, in order to take the class you must buy a \$35 kit from Stacy. The kit includes all of the materials (special hand dyed fabrics) to make two wall hangings. The class is limited to 20 students so don't forget to sign up and bring your \$10 class fee to one of our August meetings. 
