# CRQG Program News

At our **November 13** day meeting, Annie Kellum and Linda Jones taught us how to use the Deb Tucker Lemoyne Star I ruler. At the **November 20** night meeting, we were shown demos by The Clever Quilter and Accuquilt by Doris Davis, Linda Jones and Joany Orsi.

#### January 2015 Program

Our program for **Jan 8**<sup>th</sup> is a Trunk Show by Robin Meyer. She is very talented and creative and has won many awards for her quilts. We will certainly be starting the New Year off with a special treat.

The **Jan 22<sup>nd</sup> night program will be a sewing machine maintenance and pointers discussion led by Joe Phillips. He** has a wealth of knowledge and experience on how to maintain your machine and keep it in the best shape. Feel free to bring questions.

Our first class of the year, Hexagon Fun! will be on Feb 12<sup>th</sup> at our day meeting. Our instructor, Julia Wood, has been a guest on Quilting Arts TV and has co-written a book, Quick and Easy Hexie Quilts. The list of what you need to bring to the class is below and will also be posted on our web site. You do **not** need to bring your machine to the class.

#### **Hexagon Fun!**

We'll learn two ways to make hexagons for quilts: English Paper Piecing and from circles of fabric. Each participant may choose to make either a mug rug or a pincushion using the hexagon technique of their choice. Once you've learned to make hexagons using these methods, you'll love adding them to your quilts!

#### **General Supply List:**

Hand sewing needles (sharp and small such as quilting betweens)

Thread in a neutral color, Scissors, Thimble.

Fabric in two coordinating colors (one fat quarter of each)

Circle template measuring about 3" in diameter (wide mouth Mason jar lid is perfect!)

Pen or pencil to mark fabric

For Mug Rug: also need 10" square piece of felt

**For Pincushion:** also need approximately 1 cup crushed walnut shells (available in pet stores as reptile bedding) (In addition, Linda Jones plans to bring her Accuquilt circle die to help with cutting out the 3" circles.)
