CRQG Program News

The list of the 2015 programs, workshops, and Saturday Stitch-Ins are posted on the website.

The **Feb 12 day program** is presented by Julia Wood. She is scheduled to do both a trunk show and the class described below. Bring your lunch and plan to stay with us until 3PM.

Hexagon Fun!

We'll learn two ways to make hexagons for quilts: English Paper Piecing and from circles of fabric. Each participant may choose to make either a mug rug or a pincushion using the hexagon technique of their choice. Once you've learned to make hexagons using these methods, you'll love adding them to your quilts!

General Supply List:

- Hand sewing needles (sharp and small such as quilting between)
- Thread in a neutral color
- Scissors
- Thimble
- Fabric in two coordinating colors (one fat quarter of each)
- Circle template measuring about 3" in diameter (wide mouth Mason jar lid is perfect!)
- Pen or pencil to mark fabric

For Mug Rug: also need 10" square piece of felt

For Pincushion: also need approximately 1 cup crushed walnut shells (available in pet stores as reptile bedding)

(In addition, Linda Jones plans to bring her Accuquilt circle die to help with cutting out the 3" circles.)

I will be overseeing the February night program, but will be relying on member participation. We will discuss new ideas on borders, borders we like, borders we don't like, and whether or not certain quilts need a border. PLEASE help make it a fun night by bringing a quilt with a border you like, one you aren't happy with, and/or a quilt top you can't decide on. I promise you'll get lots of opinions. Thank you for helping out.
