President's Letter

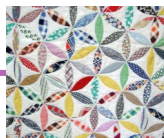
Hello everyone,

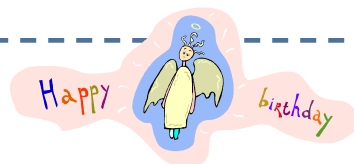

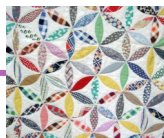

IT'S BABY QUILTS FOR 2015

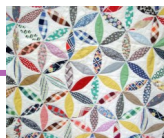

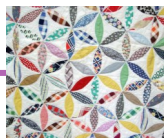

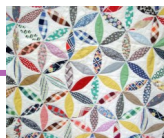

Sunshine - Irene thanked everyone for their show of concern. If you know of anyone in need of a little sunshine in their life, call Irene.

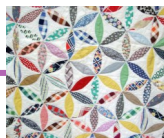
Telephone - Queen made her calls

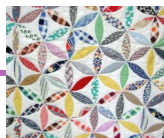
