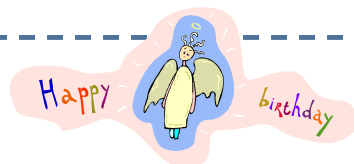

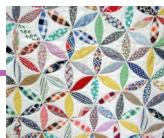

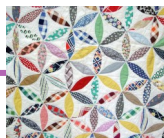

Ways and Means – new: 4th of July wreath by Rita Perez available for raffle.

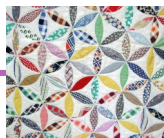
Old business: none

Even if you haven't signed up for a time slot on Saturday or Sunday, please feel free to come whenever you can. Remember, you can bring some hand sewing projects to work on.

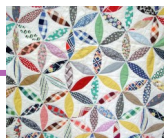
Friday - if you are able to come Friday, to help set up. Please come.
