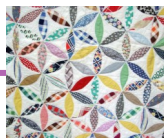

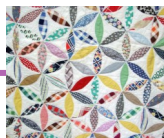

Please have the grid of horizontal and vertical lines already drawn on your batting and have your strips cut. Sarah would like to start the class with sewing not preparing to sew. All members are encouraged to stay, watch and learn about how to make a bargello quilt. We plan to stay until 3PM, so please bring your lunch.

The **November 19th** night meeting will be a fun hands-on activity called the no-sew Christmas ornament. We will also introduce an additional craft, the no sew Christmas tree. All you need to bring is a thimble, a smile, and we will introduce a little Christmas cheer!

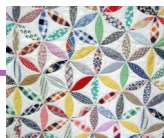

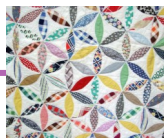
