President's Letter

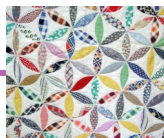
Hello Quilters,

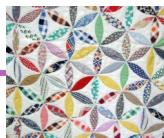

Community Service - Emily and Diane thanked the membership for all the beautiful quilts they have made for the birthing center at Wellstar. Emily said she had received 41 quilts from members.

The workshop will be held at Heritage Baptist Church which is on the corner of Rose Avenue and Selman Drive. Saturday, January 16th, 10AM-4PM

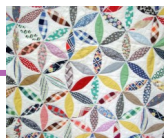

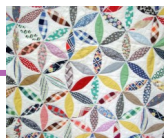

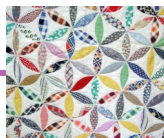
