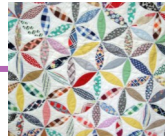

**Location:** Heritage Baptist Church, 8800 Rose Avenue, Douglasville, at the corner of Rose Avenue and Selman Dr.

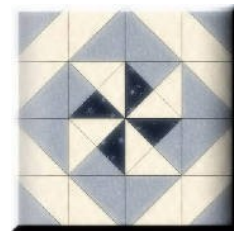
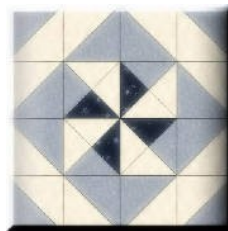

Susan is an award winning quilt maker who started her journey in 1981 and today continues to wow her audiences with her unique artistry. You can find more info on her [website](#).

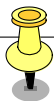
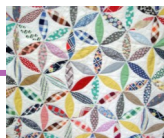

Saturday Stitch-In will be May 14 9am to 9 pm at First United Methodist Church on corner of Hospital Dr. and Prestley Mill Rd.

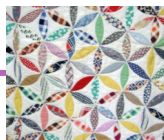
