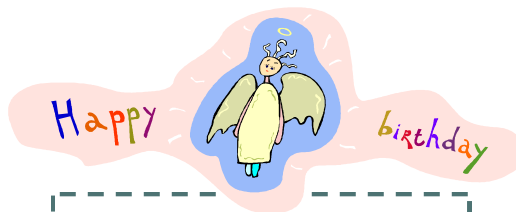

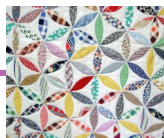

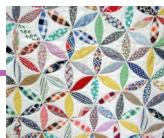
Revised Supply list for Shannon's Sketchbook

Cost of pattern is \$12.00 *** Emma Parker has the signup sheet

1. Fabric: (easiest) 5 coordinating fat quarters and several "scraps" of fabric.
One of the five fat quarters can be used for binding
If you would like the cover quilted, please quilt before the class.
Another option is to buy a piece of pre-quilted fabric.
Final cut measurement is 10½" x 20" (See pattern for detailed instructions).
2. 1/2 yard of fusible fleece
3. 8" square of Pellon interfacing (Pellon 806 or similar weight)
4. 2" piece of 1/2" velcro
5. Composition notebook (pattern is for a 7 1/2" x 9 3/4" notebook)
6. Marker pen
7. Pack of multicolored markers or pencils*
8. Single pencil or pen*
9. 6" plastic ruler*
10. Sewing machine - good working order with: 1/4" foot, zipper foot, free motion or walking foot.
11. Cutting mat, ruler, and cutter

**optional—do not need for the class only to complete the notebook.*

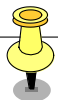
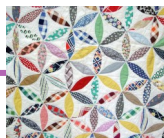

Challenge Quilt—"I Love the Holidays!"

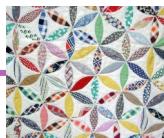
Our members have voted and chose the theme of "I Love the Holidays!" You may choose which holiday you wish to celebrate with your quilt challenge.
