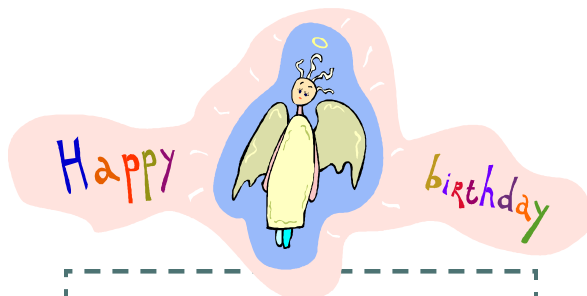

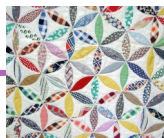

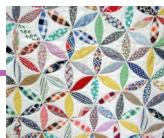

Saturday, November 12, 2016

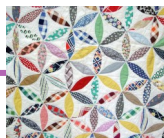
9am to 9pm — Just \$10

Linda Mikos had shoulder surgery.

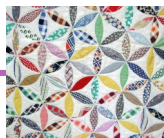

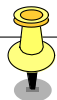
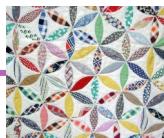
Christmas Party
