tickets or even just donate. Bring your beautiful log cabin quilts for Show and Tell, and it may encourage someone to make one for themselves.

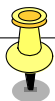
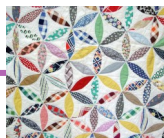
Themes for the rest of the year will soon be shared with everyone. If you have an idea, make sure to let me know.

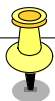
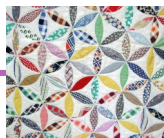

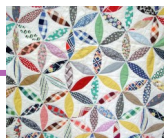

Membership: 23 members present. Door prize winners were Barbara Stephens, Jill Strorer and Irene Gardner.

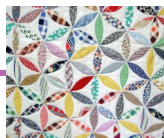
