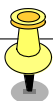
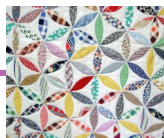

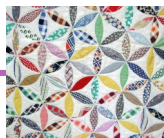
2017 Challenge Diamonds are a Girl's Best Friend

We are encouraging all members to participate and enjoy this year's challenge! There are just a few rules:

- Diamond shapes should constitute the majority of the shapes used in the quilt.
- There will be 2 categories: art quilting and traditional quilting. You can participate in either category - your choice.
- Anything quilted is okay, such as tote bags, table runners, wall hangings or quilts.
- The only size restriction is that the perimeter be 240 inches or less.

At the June 22, Quilt Camp, Linda Jones will demonstrate how to cut diamonds using a Shape Cut ruler. Lets get those quilt challenge projects started!

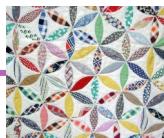
