

Program News

The November day program (Nov. 9th) will be Quilted Postcards with Danielle Morgan. These are quilts that can be mailed! If you've ever wanted to send a quilt to someone but couldn't imagine spending the next 3 weeks, 3 months or 3 years making a quilt, then a postcard might be the PERFECT project for you. The fun of making a postcard quilt is that you can play with things you're not sure you'd want to make 12 blocks of, or a machine quilting attempt you're not sure you can manage, or a test of fabrics you're not sure will work together. It's easy and less expensive than the Hallmark greeting cards you can buy.

Inspiration? There are great books on postcard making you can go online and search "fabric postcard" and select "images" rather than "web". If you don't get at least 200 pictures to look at, then you can come to check out Danielle's Pinterest pages:

Supply list:

- Sewing machines
- Regular sewing supplies (thread, scissors, ruler, cutter, board, etc.)
- One or two irons and boards.
- A few spools of colorful threads.
- Scrap fabric for both backgrounds and features. (Doesn't have to be a lot. Think 2-3 postcards.)
- If you have fabric with kid designs or other types of novelty prints bring them along.
- One box of freezer paper should serve the whole group.
- WonderUnder or other fusible is encouraged, or a glue stick.
- Optional: orphan blocks, lace, ribbon, buttons or other decorative trims. DON'T feel you need to go shopping.
- Batting and card backs will be supplied in the class.

The November night meeting (Nov 16) will be "What's New at Market" by Angela Gubler. Always a great time to see what's new and buy something you may not have seen to the quilt shops.
