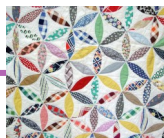


Sunshine

Membership: Denise reported that 31 members are present.

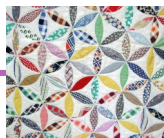
New Business: Ballots for voting on 2018 officers were handed out and retrieved. The night meeting will do the same. The total votes will be announced at the Christmas party.

Thanks to Charlie for his leadership in 2017.

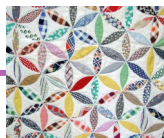
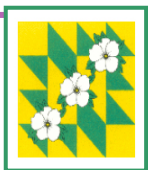
A discussion was had regarding My Grove. This site will be used for membership and notifications next year.
