

#### January 2020 Day Meeting...

Irene Gardner will be teaching our group how to create funny, whimsical face blocks that can be used as quilt blocks, table runners, project bags, wall hangings, etc. Each person will construct at least one face. Have fun creating faces that might resemble your quilting pals or even yourself! This project is fun and very addicting, so plan on making several faces!

Supplies needed to construct your own face design:

If you can find it...Quilters Yearbook by Amy Bradley . PDF can be downloaded from <a href="https://www.amybradleydesigns.com">https://www.amybradleydesigns.com</a> For \$4.50 if they mention the name of the guild

10 -12inch fabric square for background (one square for each face block)

pen or pencil and fabric markers for coloring in facial highlights

paper cutting scissors

fabric cutting scissors

Heat n' Bond lite paper-backed fusible, at least half a yard.

Skin tones fabric for faces and assorted small (FQ or smaller) fabric scraps; for making facial features, like eyes, lips, hair, glasses, etc.

Iron and ironing surface

We will not do any sewing at this time, sewing machines and accessories will not be needed. Call Irene Gardner if any questions about this class.

#### January Night 2020

Once again machine Tech, Andi Barney, will teach us great info and care about our own sewing machines.

February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 – Special Saturday Workshop

We will be make a MJ Kinman birthstone block. There are 12 spaces open for sign-up for this work shop. It's only limited because of the number of patterns I ordered. If more than twenty peoples are interested, I will see if we can order more patterns.

The cost for this Saturday Workshop is a total of \$41.

You will only need your sewing machine and the kit that is included in the cost of the class.
