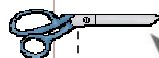

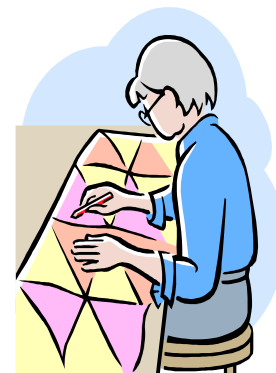

## a\_MAZE\_ing

The a\_MAZE\_ing quilt  
CHALLENGE RULES 2007

1. Cherokee Rose LOGO must appear on the front. The fabric printed logo will be provided or can be pieced.
2. Sew at least 4 mitered corners wherever borders or bindings are used.
3. Minimum SIZE: MAZE itself at least 24" square; total QUILT at least 36" square.
4. SHAPES: Square or rectangular.
5. BACKGROUNDS: Pieced or wholecloth.

The a\_MAZE\_ing quilt must have at least 1 ENTRY point and 1 EXIT point

However, multiple entry or exit points are OK.

You may enter more than one a\_MAZE\_ing quilt.

Include the grand/child in the design and/or sewing of the quilt. Make this an interactive quilting project for the child and you.
