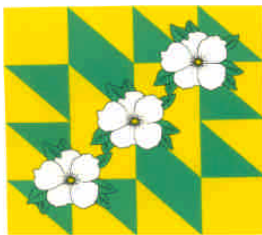

Committee Spotlight

More about the various committees that make our Guild run so well!

Programs Committee – Arranges for programs for day and night meetings and for one or two workshops during the year. Contacts speakers/teachers, makes arrangements for their presentations/classes, including any equipment needed by the speaker/teacher. Gets supply lists from teachers and distributes them to members, sets any fees needed to cover the cost of workshops or supplies and collects the fees. Gives fees collected to the Treasurer. Arranges any payment to the bank for use of the room. Provides information about programs to the membership committee, the newsletter editor and the publicity committee.

Publicity Committee – Revises, prints and distributes the guild brochure to quilt shops, fabric shops and other locations. Coordinates with local papers in order to get information about the guild printed. Sends information to the website consultant for placement on the Cherokee Rose website and checks the website periodically to make sure information is correct. Coordinates special events, such as quilt exhibits at the libraries, in order to promote the guild and educate the community about quilting.

Cherokee Rose Meetings:

June 9, 2005 - "Hollyhocks" by our very own Robin Meyer Patterns (\$8.00) will be available at the meeting for those who signed up. Bring your sewing machine, and basic sewing supplies, including a marking pencil. You will also need to press as you go, so bring an iron and ironing surface if you can. For a picture of the quilt, go to www.thedesignersworkshop.com/ucan2.phtml and scroll down to the last photo on the page - the Hollyhocks are the red flowers.

To make this quilt, you will need 5 fat quarters for the flowers, 3 fat quarters for the leaves, 4 fat quarters for the background (sky), 1 fat quarter for the center of the flowers, and border fabric of your choice. As shown in the picture, the flower fabric shades from darker to lighter, as does the background. You will need to pre-cut. Directions for cutting are in this newsletter. There are a lot of pieces, but it is not hard to cut.

We won't finish the whole quilt in class (unless you are really fast), but we will plan to sew until about 3:00. In that time, you should get enough blocks finished that you will see the variations that make up the quilt and you'll be able to finish at home. Questions?
