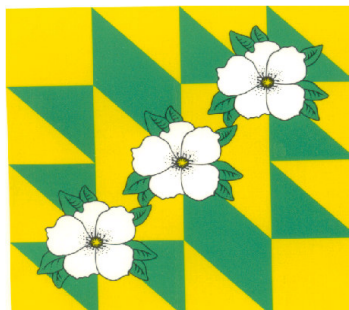

June 8th, 2006 - Day Program

"X-Block Quilt" by Linda Patton - Quilt Station
X Block (58 x 68)

Supply List:

1. Sewing Machine
2. 1/4" foot for your machine if you have one or whatever you use to get a quarter inch seam.
3. 2 or 3 full bobbins with a neutral color thread.
4. Rotary cutter, mat & ruler.
(If you have a rotating mat bring it)
5. 6 1/2" X-block ruler
(will be available for purchase)
6. Glass head pins
7. Seam Ripper
8. Cotton thread (a neutral color)
9. Fabric requirements: Fabric A & C 2 1/2 yards of two contrasting fabrics, fabric B 1 1/2 yard of an accent fabric.



Before class (1) press all fabric to get out any wrinkles. Linda likes to use spray starch when she presses her fabric, it makes it easier to cut. (2) Cut 22 strips of fabrics A & C 3 7/8". Cut 22 strips of fabric B 2 3/8". You do not need to cut all your strips if you don't want to for class, but have enough to work with. (She suggests at least 8 of each fabric, but bring all your fabric in case you want to continue with more blocks.)

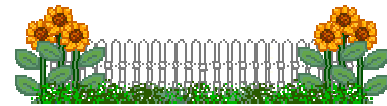

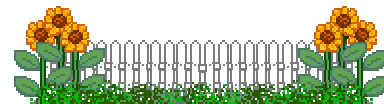
