Committee Spotlight

More about the various committees that make our Guild run so well!

Newsletter Editor – Collects information from various officers and committees and creates a paper and electronic newsletter. Prints copies of the newsletter and mails it to members using the envelopes provided by the members. Sends an electronic copy of the newsletter to the website consultant for posting on the website.

Day Hospitality Committee – Coordinates with the Programs Committee to organize lunch for day meetings. Lunch options include: ordering food in, covered dishes, bring your own lunch, or going out to lunch if the meeting ends near lunchtime. Arrives early to make coffee and set out soft drinks and ice. Brings soft drinks and ice or arranges for someone to do so. Makes sure refreshments are cleaned up, the trash can emptied and new bag installed, and the cabinet locked.

Sunshine Committee – Sends cards and makes calls to members experiencing illness or deaths in the family.

Day Telephone Committee – Calls members a few days prior to the day meeting to remind them of the meeting and provide any special reminders. If member reports illness or other problem, informs the Sunshine Committee. List of members to be called is provided by the membership committee.

Historian – Compiles scrapbooks of photographs, newspapers clippings and other materials that document the history of the guild.
