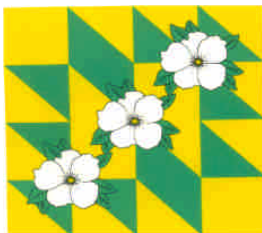

Heat and bond (at least a half yard)
Bleached muslin (at least a quarter yard)

Fabric

Trims

Appliqués

Flat decorative trims

**I'll have some stuff too

Sewing machine

Matching thread that has a zig zag stitch

*I use rayon embroidery thread

You can also use yarn scraps

The materials don't all have to be cotton

We will also need a few irons and boards

Community project will probably be completed and presented to the Guard families in November. We need a total of 68 quilts. The sign up sheets were updated to be sure we have all the quilts claimed.



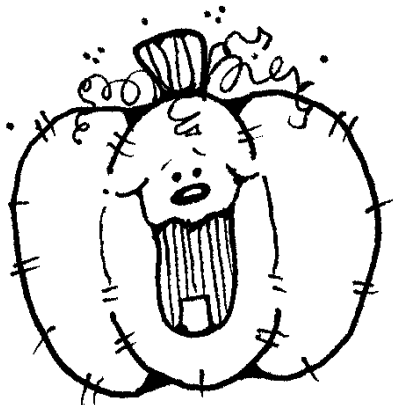
