

# Kaleidoscope Quilt Workshop

## Supply List

Sewing Machine with  $\frac{1}{4}$  in. foot

Basic Sewing Supplies

Rotary Cutter and Large Mat

Rulers – one long 24” and one smaller one

Pencil

48” square flannel, batting, or flannel-backed tablecloth for a design wall

5 Pair of Strata – Must be made before the workshop!!

### Fabric Requirements:

For the Strata --Approximately 15 different fabrics for the strata; you will cut one or two pairs of strips from each one.\*

Border – one yard – can also be used in the strata or something that coordinates.

### How to Make your Strata

The goal is to create your own unique striped fabric by sewing sets of random width strips. You will need to make 5 matching pairs of strata (a total of ten strata). Strips are cut from selvedge to selvedge in widths between 1” and 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  “. A completed strata should measure approximately 8” across the strips and be about 42” long.

Press the seams of one strata all in one direction. Press the seams of its identical mate all in one direction too, but in the opposite direction from the first strata. Accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ ” seams will make the cutting and sewing process easier.

Strata must be made before the class begins!!

\* Tip for making sure your 2 strips are exactly the same size: Lay your fabric on the cutting mat folded-selvage to selvedge. Then fold your fabric once again-cut edge to cut edge. Trim this edge to make it straight. Now go ahead and cut your strip. You will have 2 identical strips
