
Strip Pieced Foundation Block

Quilts of Valor Sew-In Symposium

Sponsored by the Georgia Quilt Council and SewFree Retreats

The technique is foundation strip piecing. Make a 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block of strips sewn diagonally.

- You can vary the size of the strips in a block between $1\frac{1}{2}$, 2" and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide
- Use ONLY patriotic colors and prints red, white, blue and gold
- Please use 100% cotton, nice quality cotton say to yourself, "Would I like this fabric in a quilt?" IMPORTANT: pre-wash fabric, especially red



- Start with a 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square of muslin see #1
- Lay your first strip of fabric face up along the middle, diagonally see #2
- Lay your second strip face down on top of your first strip See #3
- Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam along the outside edge, then flip and press See #3 & See #4
- Continue this flip and press technique all the way to the edge on both sides of the center diagonal strip until the muslin square is covered see #5
- Do NOT trim up the block, we'll recycle the scraps!
- Attach your name to the block with a safety pin
 - You CAN make more than one (1) block if you wish !!

All blocks must be sent in by July 15, 2011


